The Constitution of the Confederate States of America

1 We, the people of the Confederate States, each State acting for itself,
2 and in its sovereign and independent character, in order to form a permanent
3 Federal Government, establish justice, ensure domestic tranquility, and se4 cure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity—to which ends we
5 invokeing the favor and guidance of Almighty God—do ordain and establish
6 this Constitution for the Confederate States of America.
